Honeypot Road bridge installation of permanent anti-throw screens - UPDATE

Dear Resident/Business Owner

The Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure (DPTI) would like to inform you of changes to the upcoming installation of permanent anti-throw screens on Honeypot Road.

The planned closures of Honeypot Road bridge will now be undertaken as **night works over a four day period** from **Friday**, **7 December at 7:30pm** until **Tuesday 11 December at 6:00am**, weather permitting.

During this time Honeypot bridge will be closed to all traffic with local traffic diversions in place. These diversions are shown in yellow on the attached map.

The Southern Expressway will be closed to traffic each night during these works between Main South Road, Hackham (Southern End of the expressway) and the Beach Road Interchange. The Expressway will be open to traffic between approximately 7am and 7:30pm daily during the works.

Motorists traveling south on the expressway will need to exit via the Beach Road Interchange and continue either using Main South Road or Lonsdale Road. This diversion is shown in orange on the attached map.

Northbound motorists accessing the Expressway will be detoured via Main South Road and will enter the Expressway from Beach Road interchange. This diversion is shown in blue on the attached map.

Road users are advised to follow the direction of traffic management staff and observe VMS boards and local traffic management signage. Pedestrians and cyclists will be detoured to nearby pedestrian bridges or road bridges.

Access to businesses and properties will be maintained at all times.

Emergency services and public transport will still be able to use the Expressway.

Every effort will be made to minimise noise impacts to nearby residents and businesses. However some noise will be unavoidable during this period.
